DIRECTORS' REPORT

The directors of SIN HENG CHAN (MALAYA) BERHAD have pleasure in submitting their report and the audited financial statements of the Group and of the Company for the financial year ended December 31, 2001.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The Company is principally an investment holding company.

The principal activities of the subsidiary companies are as disclosed under Note 3 to the Financial Statements.

During the financial year, a subsidiary company commenced the planting of fragrant coconut trees in order to maximise utilisation of breeding farm lands for future additional revenue.

Other than as stated above, there have been no significant changes in the nature of the activities of the Company and of its subsidiary companies during the financial year.

RESULTS OF OPERATIONS

The results of operations of the Group and of the Company for the financial year are as follows:

In the opinion of the directors, the results of operations of the Group and of the Company during the financial year have not been substantially affected by any item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature.

DIVIDENDS

No dividend has been paid, proposed or declared by the Company since the end of the previous financial year. The Company does not have distributable reserve for dividend payment in respect of the current financial year.

RESERVES AND PROVISIONS

There were no material transfers to or from reserves or allowance during the financial year other than those disclosed in the financial statements.

ISSUE OF SHARES AND DEBENTURES

The Company has not issued any new shares or debentures during the financial year.

SHARE OPTIONS

The Sin Heng Chan (Malaya) Berhad Employees' Share Option Scheme ("ESOS") is governed by the by-laws which was approved by the shareholders at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on November 19, 1996.

The salient features of the ESOS are as follows:

- (a) The total number of shares available under the ESOS shall not exceed 10% of the issued share capital of the Company;
- (b) Eligible persons are executive directors and confirmed employees of the Group with at least 12 months of continuous service;
- (c) The option price for each ordinary share of RM1 shall be the average of the middle market quotation of the Company's shares as shown in the daily official list issued by the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange for the 5 trading days preceding the offer date or at nominal value of the share, whichever is higher;
- (d) The option period commences from February 4, 1997 and ended on January 21, 2002;
- (e) The offer is personal to the eligible employees and directors to whom the offer is made and cannot be assigned, transferred or disposed of under any circumstances; and
- (f) The persons to whom the options are granted have no right to participate by virtue of the options in any share issue of any other company.

OTHER FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Before the income statements and the balance sheets of the Group and of the Company were made out, the directors took reasonable steps:

- (a) to ascertain that proper action had been taken in relation to the writing off of bad debts and the making of allowance for doubtful debts, and have satisfied themselves that all known bad debts had been written off and that adequate allowance had been made for doubtful debts; and
- (b) to ensure that any current assets which were unlikely to realise their book values in the ordinary course of business have been written down to their estimated realisable values.

As of December 31, 2001, the Group and the Company have capital deficiency of RM26,242,724 and RM21,400,103 as a result of operational losses incurred in the current and prior years and current liabilities exceeding current assets by RM40,366,230 and RM34,004,015 respectively. These factors, along with other matters as set forth in Note 32 to the Financial Statements, raise substantial doubt as to whether the Group and the Company will be able to continue as a going-concern. However, the financial statements of the Group and of the Company have been drawn up on the basis of accounting principles applicable to a going-concern. The ability of the Group and of the Company to continue as a going-concern is dependent on the successful implementation of the Proposal as fully explained in Note 32 to the Financial Statements.

Other than as stated in the preceding paragraph, at the date of this report, the directors are not aware of any circumstances:

- (a) which would render the amount written off for bad debts or the amount of the allowance for doubtful debts in the financial statements of the Group and of the Company inadequate to any substantial extent; or
- (b) which would render the values attributed to current assets in the financial statements of the Group and of the Company misleading; or

- (c) which have arisen which render adherence to the existing method of valuation of assets or liabilities of the Group and of the Company misleading or inappropriate; or
- (d) not otherwise dealt with in this report or financial statements which would render any amount stated in the financial statements of the Group and of the Company misleading.

At the date of this report, there does not exist:

- (a) any charge on the assets of the Group and of the Company which has arisen since the end of the financial year which secures the liability of any other person; or
- (b) any contingent liability of the Group and of the Company which has arisen since the end of the financial year.

No contingent or other liability has become enforceable or is likely to become enforceable within the period of twelve months after the end of the financial year which, in the opinion of the directors, will or may substantially affect the ability of the Group or of the Company to meet their obligations as and when they fall due.

In the opinion of the directors, no item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature has arisen in the interval between the end of the financial year and the date of this report which is likely to affect substantially the results of operations of the Group and of the Company for the succeeding financial year.
