




EPF MOBILE TEAM

After the beneficial EPF talk in March, the EPF Mobile team Kota Kinabalu, led by En. Harun arranged their services to all staff in KK to register for the i-Akaun and nomination.

The process was simplified for our staff who wanted to register on the i-Akaun and their nomination. All they required was a copy of their MyKad. Staff could register and obtain the activation code on the spot by filling up the form prepared by the Mobile team. The i-Akaun service will allow the staff to check on EPF statements, withdrawal application status and history, eligible amount for withdrawals, savings and investments and update profile.

On top of that, staff also can name on their family member(s) as a nominee/administrator to receive/administer their EPF savings upon the member's death. They just need to fill up the nomination form with the segregation of % on their own will. The nomination will facilitate and expedite the withdrawal of the member's savings by the nominated family member(s) in the event of death.

The arrangement for the EPF Mobile team to visit our office has helped staff tremendously. Rather than going to EPF office in town where they may need to face long queue and traffic, and may take some time to process, they only need to bring the MyKad and copy to settle it.

The response was good and great! Majority of the staff from Lot 2 & Lot 7 had registered and nominated their family member(s) from the service provided by the EPF Mobile Team. Staff also understand the importance of the i-Akaun and nomination better now.


