




IN THE WORKPLACE TRAINING

According to WHS Council, chemicals are used extensively in workplaces and even in our homes. Many products such as paint, plastics, adhesives, detergents, and pharmaceuticals are derived from chemicals, some of which could potentially be harmful. However, for many toxic chemicals, the health effects may take a long period of time to develop.





The Chemical Management training was organized by Chemsain HRD on the 12-13th July 2017 at M Hotel, Kuching, and a very positive response was received from our clients for this training. A total of 29 participants together with OSH1 & Water Business team. For this topic, we managed to get a former Senior Officer of DOSH Malaysia with 26 years of experience in Occupational Safety & Health field, Dr. Syed Abdul Hamid, as a speaker.

On the first day, the training was focused on the Act and Regulation of CIMAH Regulations, USECHH Regulations & CLASS 2013 Regulations. This is more to the theory of OSH regulations and understanding of proper chemical management concept before they proceeded to the group activity on the last day training.

The group activity included were:

- Discussion on the Safety Data Sheet
- Labelling of the chemical
- Understanding the importance of ITP (Information To Public) & creating an ITP sheet whereby should the worst case scenario happen to public & how to disseminate the information to them.
- Explaining the importance of safety reports by competent person.
- Demonstration of safe operation


